

All freshmen & sophomores will be taking the PreACT Secure on **Tuesday, April 8th**.

Freshman may leave after the PreACT Secure test is complete. Please make arrangements to pick up your child at 12:00 pm from the commons. There are no other classes in the afternoon on April 8th.

Sophomores will take the WI Forward Exam for social studies after they complete the PreACT Secure. There will be a short lunch break in between. A “grab and go” hot lunch will be provided for anyone wanting to take hot lunch. All other sophomores should bring a cold lunch. The WI Forward Exam for social studies is self-paced for each student. Sophomores are able to leave after their WI Forward Exam is completed. The average time for taking this exam is 70 minutes. Sophomores may be picked up from the commons sometime around 1:15 depending on how long the test takes them to complete. They are also welcome to stay in the commons if they have a practice to attend at 3:15. The commons will be supervised for those needing to stay.

Important Information:

- All students must arrive **before** 7:50am. We will begin testing right at 7:50am – do not be late!
- Freshmen will finish testing at approx. 11:45am and may go home after testing is completed. (approx. 12:00)
- Sophomores will be finished around 1:15 and may go home after testing is complete.
- Bring a snack to eat during break. Sophomores may bring a lunch if they do not want the grab and go lunch.

The **PreACT Secure** is an online test. Each student will need to bring their laptop (completely charged) for this test. The test breakdown is as follows:

English	35 minutes
Math	45 minutes
Break	10 minutes
Reading	40 minutes
Science	35 minutes

The **WI Forward Exam** is self paced and on average takes about 70 minutes to complete. Sophomores are required to have a laptop and headphones for the test.

What to bring for both the PreACT Secure & WI Forward Exams:

- Your **FULLY CHARGED SCHOOL LAPTOP**. (CANNOT BE A PERSONAL DEVICE)
- Snack and water bottle
- Calculator
- Pencils
- **HEADPHONES- Sophomores only (WI Forward Exam**

What not to bring:

- No cell phones, smart watches or other electronic devices are allowed.
- No other books or materials are allowed during testing.
